THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

This Sunday we celebrate the Solemn Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, or Corpus Christi, The purpose of the feast is to bring home to all of us the great importance of the Eucharist in our Christian lives. Jesus gave us the Eucharist at the Last Supper. It is a remarkable gift. At Mass we can experience and be touched by Christ's great act of love on our behalf. In the words of Consecration we meet the full force of his words of love on our behalf. "this is my body, which will be given up for you." This is the chalice of my blood.... Which will be poured out for you." Jesus gives up his body, his total humanity, himself, for our benefit. He also sheds his blood, his very life substance, for our good. This takes place for us every time we celebrate Mass in the church in Bunclody.

This is not the only expression of his love for us in the Eucharist. We come to Holy Communion. We receive the Body of Christ, which brings us into immediate personal contact with himself. That gives us the opportunity to be close to him, to pray to him, to have conversation with him in our own words. We are intimately invited to Christ, but through him we are bonded to each other. We cannot bypass the remarkable words of St. Paul. "The fact that there is only one loaf means that, though there are many of us, we form a single body, because we all have a share in this one loaf." When we receive the Eucharist we say "Amen", we say "Yes" to receiving the body of Christ, but we also say "Yes" to who we are, the body of Christ, the community of faith in which Christ is fully alive. The call of the Eucharist is that we go out and live the Eucharist and act as the Body of Christ in our daily lives by giving ourselves for the benefit of each other, as Jesus did.
