## THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

The first Pentecost was a great and critical day for the church. It marks the beginning of our church's journey. The immediate apostles and followers of Jesus had an extraordinary experience. All were touched by the Holy Spirit. He came to them in tongues of fire. Straight away, they were emboldened and began to speak with confidence and conviction. The great crowds gathered in Jerusalem for the great feast were astonished and bewildered that they could understand them in their own language. Their preaching had a profound effect. Many believed and began to build a community of faith. The Apostles had a very similar experience later in the Acts of the Apostles. "As they prayed, the house where they were assembled rocked. From this time they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to proclaim the word of God fearlessly". Before the Spirit came to them they were beset with fear, now they go out and preach the word of God with courage, conviction and confidence. Their influence was immense and thousands came to embrace the faith they preached.

Every Christian receives the gift of the Holy Spirit in Baptism and confirmation. All of us have the responsibility to pass on the faith that is ours in virtue of this great gift. We are not expected to ascend a soapbox and address the multitude in the town square. Yet we give quiet and effective witness by the lifestyle we portray, by the example we give and by the active role we take in educating and forming our children in accord with the Gospel way of life, and also by talking with each other about our faith and what matters to us in life. We should always keep in mind that the Holy Spirit is at hand to remove our fear and give us courage and conviction to give witness to the grace that is ours.
