THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

In Sunday's Gospel we have the story of the miraculous catch of fish. The disciples had worked all night but had caught nothing. After Jesus finished preaching from the boat he asked Peter to put out into deep water and pay out the nets for a catch. They netted such a large number of fish that the nets were tearing. They asked the companion boats to come to their assistance and they did.

Peter was deeply moved by what had happened. He saw Jesus at work. He concluded that he had powers beyond any human person. This was the action of someone who had exercised the power of God. 
Pastoral Council Meeting
