THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

This weekend we celebrate the Paschal Mystery. We think of the Death and Resurrection of Jesus. Jesus was a good man who was also the Son of God. His ministry was one of love and enlightenment. He came to uncover the mystery of God and the mystery of ourselves for us. He chose the way of death to express his great love for each of us. St Paul reminds us of the full meaning of Jesus' death. "The life that I am now living, ... I am living in faith, faith in the Son of God who loves me and gave himself for me." He loved us by giving himself on our behalf and for our benefit. His death also expressed his love for his heavenly Father. He chose to fulfil the Father's will rather than his own. In response, his Father raised him from the dead and he came to walk once more on this earth. Later he returned to the Father to become the head of the church and the one who leads the people of God to true life.

There is a very clear connection between the death and resurrection of Christ and our own lives. Jesus' decisive moment of death happened in Gethsemane when he made up his mind to carry out his Father's will. There he died to all the self-will and selfishness in himself in order to show his love for his Father and for all of us. We too are challenged to do the same in our love of God and of each other. If we follow the example of Jesus, then we will rise to a better and more fulfilled life that will anticipate a permanent life with the Risen Christ beyond this world.
