THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

Following current guidelines, Fr O' Connor has decided to limit mass attendance to 100 people. **All masses are currently due to take place.** Changes may be made next week. The Parish Office will open as normal, however this may also change.

We ask **anyone feeling unwell please not to attend Mass**, and get Mass online by going to mcnmedia.com and searching for "Bunclody", watching mass on television, or listening to Mass on the radio.

The following rules have been implemented:

- ♦ Those who attend mass are asked to **stay at least 3 feet apart** to limit possible virus transmission through contact.
- ♦ Parishioners should cover mouth and nose with a clean tissue when coughing or sneezing and dispose of the tissue as soon as possible.
- ♦ Practice good hand hygiene (frequent hand washing), and carry hand sanitizer for times when soap and water is not available.
- ♦ The sign of peace should not be expressed by physical contact.
- ♦ Communion will only be administered in to the hand.
- ♦ Collection boxes will be left at the main entrance to the church to limit possible virus transmission through passing collection baskets.
- ♦ All Confirmations have been suspended until further notice.
- ♦ Communion and Confirmation preparatory masses are also suspended until further notice.
- ♦ **Weddings, baptisms, and funerals can go ahead provided fewer than 100 people attend.** Priority will be given to family members to attend these ceremonies.
- ♦ Holy Water Fonts should be emptied and not used.
