THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

Peter went to Jesus and asked, "Lord, how often must I forgive my brother if he wrongs me? As often as seven times?" Jesus answered, "Not seven, I tell you, but seventy seven times." Jesus makes it very clear there is no end to the number of times that we forgive one another.

Jesus tells a powerful parable to highlight the importance of the forgiveness. A king went to settle his accounts with his servants. One owed him ten thousand talents, an enormous sum of money, would be worth millions nowadays. The servant was in no position to pay back the debt. He pleaded with his master to give him time. But the king looked at his real situation, at the stress and anxiety he would experience and at the inevitable suffering for his family. The king with remarkable generosity and mercy, cancelled this enormous debt.

But the servant went out and found a man who owed him a few shillings. He was totally self-righteous, showed no consideration and had the man thrown into prison. The other servants took it badly and reported to the king. The king showed no pity to him, tortured him until he was able to pay his enormous debt.

The king represents God for us all. He is enormously generous and merciful. He stands ready to forgive even our most horrible sins. If we turn to him with humility and sorrow he will cancel all our debts and allow us back into his friendship. God is infinitely generous in forgiving us. He calls on us to show a similar generosity in forgiving each other. Forgiveness may be difficult. But it is the only secret to put behind us our former and recent hurts.
