THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

In this Sunday's Gospel poses a question for his listeners. A man had two sons. He said to one of them, "Go and work in the vineyard today." He said that he would not but thought better of it later and went. The other son was asked by the father to do the same. He said that he would certainly go and then did not go. Jesus raised the question, "Which of them did the father's will?"

A question we ought to put to ourselves all the time is "What is God's will for me?" Sometimes we have a sense of what God wants of us but we carry on as if it did not matter. We know that it is wrong to deceive other people and tell lies, but still we do. We have a realisation that sexuality is a great gift from God and is intended in marriage to express love and bring about new life, still people persist in having casual affairs which shows little respect for the dignity or sexuality of the other person.

One of the great things about human beings is that we can change. The first son changed his mind and did what was required of him. We can go through much of life bent on injustice, disrespect and deceit. Maybe, an instance, a word from someone else, or an outstanding example can lead us to rethink our situation and come to understand what God wants of us in the situations of ordinary life. Young women intent on abortion have changed their intention having experienced the joy of a mother who had given birth to a child.

The challenge for all of us is to discover what is God's will for us in all the situations of life. There is a short cut. In the person of Jesus and his teaching we find all the keys.
