

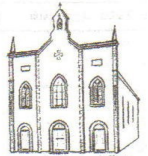

## THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

Today we mark the first Sunday of the Season of Creation 2020, which runs from 1 September to 4 October. This special season in the church calendar celebrates the joy of creation, while encouraging awareness of initiatives to protect the natural environment.

We are reminded during this time of our duty to care for what Pope Francis calls our "common home". When we hear the word "home", we tend to think of the immediate place where we live and the people we share it with - our house or living space and our immediate family, neighbours and community. Each of us lives within a particular web of relationships that we call home. But we must be conscious too that we live in a wider relationship with the earth and with all of creation. We all live in a common home, and we all must care for it, and for each other.

Our gospel today sees Jesus offer some advice about living in community. He first acknowledges that communities are far from perfect. We all struggle with our relationships and duties. But he makes one thing clear: in a community, we all have a responsibility to each other and to work to build harmony.

This responsibility extends beyond our immediate environment to our world. In this Season of Creation, we remember in particular those who are suffering as a result of environmental damage. The way we live on this earth has consequences for the world and its people, and indeed for future generations. Over the next few weeks, let us consider how we might make some changes that reflect our care for others and for our common home.

*"We need to strengthen the conviction that we are one single human family." (Pope Francis, Laudato Si')*

### Reflection for weekend 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> September 2020

"they ....went through the towns, preaching" Luke: 9

A man going to church saw four boys hanging out on a street corner, and invited them to go with him. They did, and returned the following Sunday. These boys became the centre of the Sunday school class he taught. Years later his friends contacted the boys, to invite them to write a birthday letter to be read at a surprise party for their teacher. Their letters were eye opening. One had become a missionary in China, one the president of the US Federal Reserve Bank, one was private secretary to President Hoover, and the fourth was President Hoover himself. Sometimes small encounters are God-encounters that take place when you're busy with other things. If unprepared you'll miss a real blessing, a chance to grow and an opportunity to put God's interest ahead of your own. Jesus left the comfort of Heaven to walk the road of human need. He didn't set up a throne in each town and say, 'This is My place, if you want to see Me come here'. No, He went to the marketplace. He went to the boats of fishermen. He went to the homes of ordinary people. Jesus went through the towns preaching the Gospel. What seems like a small encounter may be a God encounter, and produce results you never dreamed possible. *(The Word for Today)*
