<u>THE HOOK OF FAITH THIS WEEK</u>

'Synodality Explored: Facing the Future Together' is an article by Jim Thompson who recently attended a conference on synodality in Knock. The homily for the Sixth Sunday of Easter focuses on the fundamental vocation we all share in common, namely to love one another as Christ has loved us. For the Formation of Men and Women Religious and Seminarians' is the Pope's Prayer intention for May and we ask the question of whether we Catholics still love the Eucharist and why. Fr Eamonn Conway summarises a recently report on attitudes and behaviours in Catholic schools that highlights the importance of education as a formative experience. In advance of the 'Day for Life' celebrated on 16th June, Lord Alton explains the reasons why we should concerned about the protection of life and why a recent programme on Ireland's abortion laws was hopelessly imbalanced.
