THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

The symbolic gesture of breaking and sharing bread and sharing the cup, that Jesus made at the Last Supper, symbolised the offering of himself that he would make on Calvary, giving his life for others. Sometimes we also are called to give our lives for others. We can do this grudgingly or with a generous heart. What difference has it made for you when you were able to give yourself freely?

In his encyclical letter Deus Caritas Est Pope Benedict XVI wrote, 'A Eucharist which does not pass over into the concrete practice of love is essentially fragmented.' What has helped you to be aware of the importance of the link between the Eucharist and your life-style?

Jesus involved his disciples both in the preparation for the Last Supper and in its celebration. Recall times when you had a heightened awareness of participation and involvement in the Mass. What helped to give you this awareness? Are there lessons from these special experiences that you can bring with you to the routine Sunday Mass?

THE HOOK OF FAITH THIS WEEK

This weekend we celebrate the great Feast of Corpus Christi and reflect on the gift of the Eucharist. We also explore reasons why many still stay away from the Mass and how those obstacles can be removed. We have a great testimony of faith from a Wexford University student who shares his story. Fr Lar O'Connor offers an article on the 'Basic Foundation for Pastoral Ministry' and we also feature Pope Francis' prayer intention for June which is for those fleeing their own country. We have articles for the Feast of the Sacred Heart on June 7th and that of the Immaculate Heart of Mary the following day. We offer a prayer and support for those who begin their exams next week and feature the words of Bishop Donal Roche following his ordination as auxiliary bishop of Dublin last weekend.
